Eligibility

- Students age 8–17 are eligible for financial aid.

- Students age 3–7 may be considered for financial aid upon request.
- Scholarships may be applied toward tuition for Summer 2023 and/or the 2023/2024 academic year.
- Scholarships do not automatically renew. Previous scholarship students must reapply every year.
- Students will receive their scholarship determination via email 2 weeks after submitting their application.

Incomplete or late applications may not be considered.

Scholarship Student Requirements

To maintain their eligibility, scholarship students are required to:

- Adhere to Brooklyn Ballet's policies at all times
- Attend all scheduled classes, masterclasses, and workshops
- Perform in all Brooklyn Ballet performances and special events
- Set an example of professionalism at all times

Scholarship students who don't adhere may jeopardize their scholarship status and future eligibility.
