APPLICATION DEADLINE:

All applicants must complete and submit this Financial Aid Application, all supporting documents, and their 2021 Tax Return to info@brooklynballet.org with the subject line "Financial Aid Application 2022/2023" by **September 15, 2022**. Incomplete or late applications may not be considered.

ELIGIBILITY & APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Only students enrolled in the Conservatory Training Program, Level I to III/IV, are eligible for financial aid.
- Previous recipients of an Elevate Scholarship must reapply every school year. Scholarships do not automatically renew.
- Elevate Scholarships can be applied toward tuition for the academic year and/or summer programs.
- Students will receive their Scholarship Award Determination via email two weeks after submitting their application. Please make sure your contact information is correct.
- Incomplete or late applications may not be considered.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- To maintain their eligibility, scholarship students are required to:
 - Adhere to Brooklyn Ballet's policies at all times
 - Attend all scheduled classes
 - Set an example of professionalism for their peers
